If you would like to learn more about the Jill Barrett Research program, attend this meeting! Drs. Smith, Swope, and Young will be present to describe their projects and application information will be distributed.

The Jill Barrett Research Program provides research stipends of up to \$4000 and housing stipends of up to \$2500 to students participating in a 10-week long summer research project under the tutelage of a Mills Biology Department faculty member. There are 2 levels of support depending on level of responsibility and experience:

Barrett Scholar (full stipend)

Barrett Research Assistant (partial stipend)

Students with limited Biology coursework and experience are encouraged to apply for the Assistant position. Students accepting a Scholar position are expected to engage in Directed Research during the Spring 2016 semester to prepare for their summer research project, and Fall 2016 to bring their projects to closure.

Applications for the Summer 2016 program should be given to Joyce Hilton in the Biology Department Office by 4:00 pm on Friday, October 16.
