SELF-DESIGNED CONCENTRATION FOR WGSS MAJORS PROPOSAL FORM

- Students who choose to design their own concentration should work with their major advisor to pick four courses (12 credits) for their concentration.
- They should develop a title and short rationale for the concentration in consultation with their advisor.
- Students may choose courses not on the list of electives with approval from their advisor.
- Special topics courses and independent studies may count toward your concentration with advisor approval.
- No courses may meet more than one requirement for the major.
- At least six courses in the major must be at the 100 level or above.
- All Self-Designed concentrations must be approved by the Academic Standing Committee.
